Bart has also served or is currently serving on the boards of over a dozen NGO's including The Brookings Institution (Audit Committee Chair), Lincoln Center (Audit Committee Chair), The Juilliard School (Board Vice-Chair), Harvard's Graduate School of Education (Visiting Committee), Guggenheim's Works and Process (Board Chair) and as a member of the Membership Committee of the Council on Foreign Relations. He has been a Senior Advisor to Concordia since 2019.

Bart has received many honors across the years of his practice and his service on corporate and not for profit boards. The latest was in 2021 when he was recognized as "Lawyer of the Year" for Corporate Compliance Law in New York City by *Best Lawyers*.
